Judges will look for originality, neatness, the ability to communicate the theme, and for evidence that the children in each class participated in and completed the project themselves.

## Guidelines:

Contest is open to Pickens County students, Grades K5 - 4<sup>th</sup>.

Size of Poster is to be no larger than 36" x 48".

Each poster is to be the work of one class as a class project. One entry per class.

Posters cannot be returned. PSWCD reserves the right to publish images of posters.

Posters will be judged within each grade level.

Winners will be notified in writing.

Back of Poster MUST show Poster Title, Grade, School & Teacher (full name), along with a brief written description of what the class' poster represents and is meant to convey.
